#### **OTHER CONDITIONS OF PLAY**

- All games shall be played in line with the Laws of the Sport of Bowls, Crystal Mark 3rd Edition, and in accordance with the Domestic Regulations as approved by World Bowls.
- Appendix A.4. Restricting the movement of players (trips to the head) will be in effect.
- Appendix A.5. Regulations regarding slow play may be invoked if needed to keep on schedule and to avoid imposing a time limit on games.
- Time limits for games will only be imposed if the Tournament Committee deems it necessary for reasons of slow play, inclement weather, or unforeseen circumstances.
- Draw: Blind draw on day 1. An effort will be made to avoid teams from the same club playing against each other on 1<sup>st</sup> day of each event, notwithstanding mixed teams and complications of the draw.
- Rink assignments: No team will play twice on the same rink on the 1<sup>st</sup> day. On the 2<sup>nd</sup> day, some teams may play on the rink assigned on the previous day, if necessary.
- Scoring: Wins -- Ties (ties will stand) -- Losses
  - Day 1: Three points are awarded for a win. One point for a tie. No points for a loss. All games played to completion on day 1. No extra ends.
  - Day 2: In case of a tie, an extra end will be played to determine the winner.
- A bye is considered a win. Teams with a bye are allowed to practice on a rink assigned by Umpire, as available.
- Order of ranking after completion of play on day 1 based on; 1<sup>st</sup> Points; 2<sup>nd</sup> Net total shots; 3<sup>rd</sup> Shot percentage. (Triples/Singles: max net total shots, plus or minus 10; Pairs: max net total shots, plus or minus 7).
- Game stoppages: If a game is suspended due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances, the tournament committee will determine if/when the game will continue. If the game cannot be resumed, it will count as a played game if <u>all</u> teams have completed 9 ends of 14-end game (7 ends of 10-end game) or 12 shots by one person in singles. Friday, March 11 is reserved for completing uncompleted games.
- Single re-spot rule will be in effect.
- Equal distance bowls: zero shots, end played.
- Substitutions: Allowed up to the day of registration. Substitutions during the competition will be permitted for illness and bona-fide emergencies as approved by the Tournament Committee. No substitutions in singles after play has commenced.
- Drop-outs: In singles, if a drop-out occurs after completion of play on day 1 and prior to commencement of play on day 2, the flights will be re-ranked with the bye(s) moved to the last flight.
- Smoking in designated areas only.
- Cell phone must be turned off or muted. Exceptions only in emergencies and with prior approval of Umpire.
- Umpires: To be appointed by SED Head Umpire. Singles markers will be assigned as available.
- Tournament Committee has the discretion to determine and/or modify the tournament format and Conditions of Play. Some conditions as stated here may differ in part from the Policies and Procedures. Other conditions as published on the SED website may be enforced at discretion of the Committee.
- COVID-19. Be mindful we are still in the midst of a pandemic. Precaution for yourself and keeping others safe reflects who we are. At the time of this printing, our host club has requested that the unvaccinated wear masks on the MDLBC premises.
